Written by **Aisling Lally** and directed by **Ella McKeown**, **LOVE ME** is a fast-paced coming of age story following musical theatre fanatic Fran as she embarks on a self-prescribed "sex training" course. Tracking her journey to understanding the lack of sexual attraction she experiences, **LOVE ME** blends monologue, movement and poetry to navigate learning how to grow to love yourself.

Aisling's previous work includes **Messy Eaters** at York Theatre Royal, **Vibrations** at National Student Drama Festival and **Booster Seat** at the China Plate Theatre RECLAIMED Festival.

York DramaSoc was established in the early 1960s at the University of York and is one of the most active student drama societies in the country. Membership over the years has included **Simon Stephens**, **Nick Payne**, **Penelope Skinner**, **Hal Cruttenden** and **Anthony Horowitz**. **York DramaSoc** have presented an eclectic mix of shows at the Edinburgh Fringe in recent years, including dark drama **Bad Dog** by Royal Court Writers' Group alumna **Ashley Milne** and **The Same Rain That Falls on Me** by **Logan Jones** for Online@the SpaceUK Season 2.
