Maybe they're not the easiest thoughts to slide into conversation but that doesn't mean that they're unimportant. And chances are, everybody else is probably thinking about them too. So why don't we dedicate a space to sweating the things that feel like nothing and everything at the same time?

Inspired by anonymous submissions, *Sweating the Small Stuff*, written and directed by **Annabel Lunney**, is a production that explores seven recurring topics and presents them in a stand-up-but-in-the-shower sort of way. This new original production unpicks the attitudes we have towards periods, sex, our brains, masturbation, online dating, body hair and abstinence. Here, nothing is too small to sweat.

York DramaSoc has facilitated many successful careers over the years, boasting alumni including **Simon Stephens** (*Sea Wall*, *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time*), **Anthony Horowitz** (*Alex Rider*, *The Power of Five*), **Nick Payne** (*Constellations*, *A Life*). Since its establishment in the early 1960s, **York DramaSoc** has brought a diverse collection of shows to the Edinburgh Fringe, such as *One Giant Leap for June* by **Rachel Flanagan**, and dark drama *Bad Dog* by Royal Court Writers' Group alumna **Ashley Milne**.
